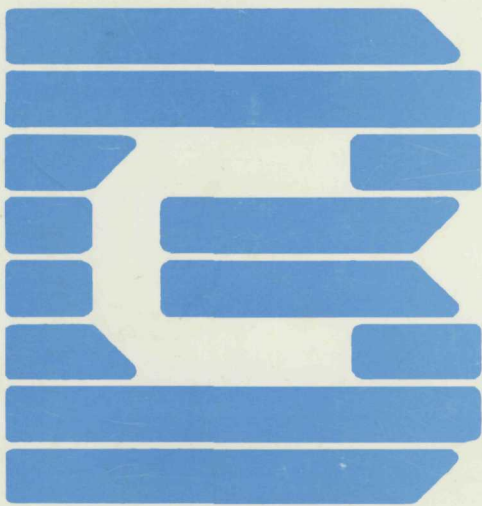

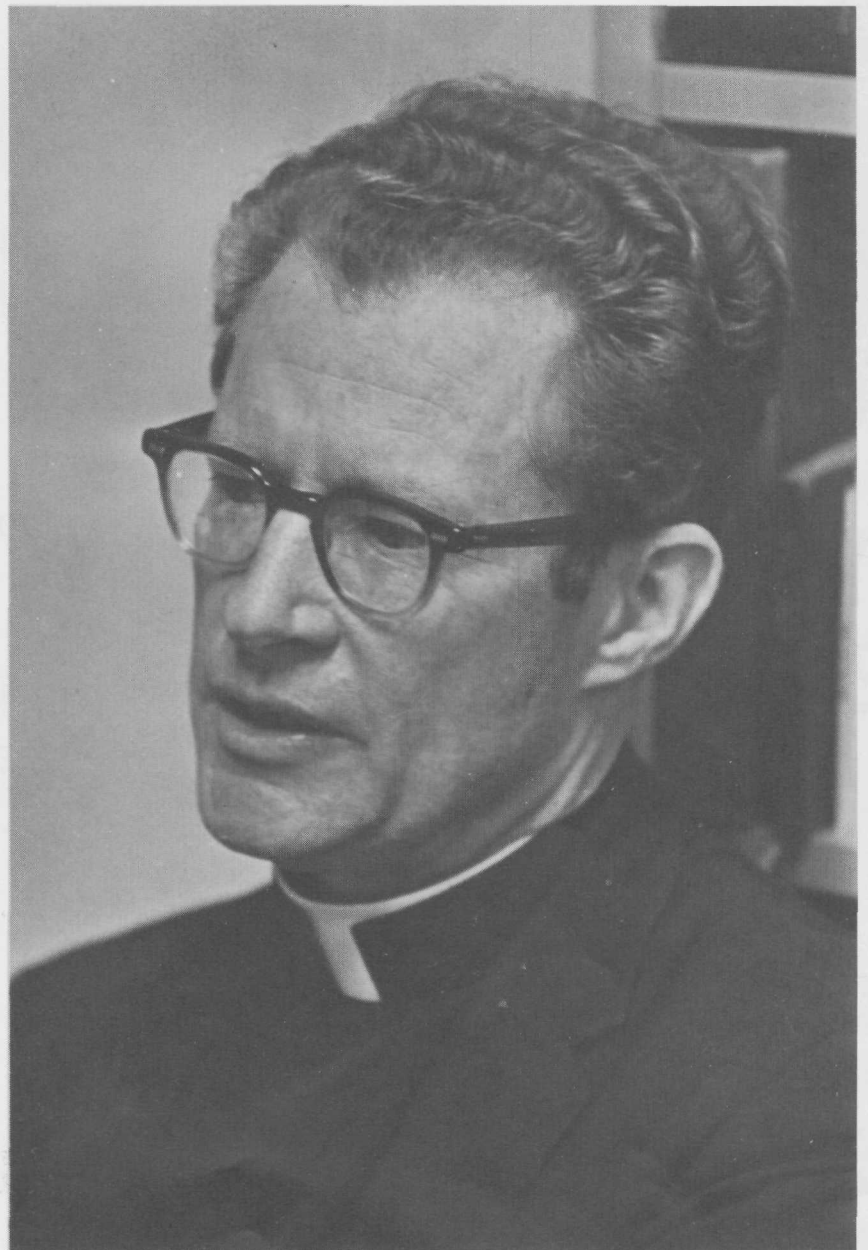

# 1977 LOGOS TRIBUTE

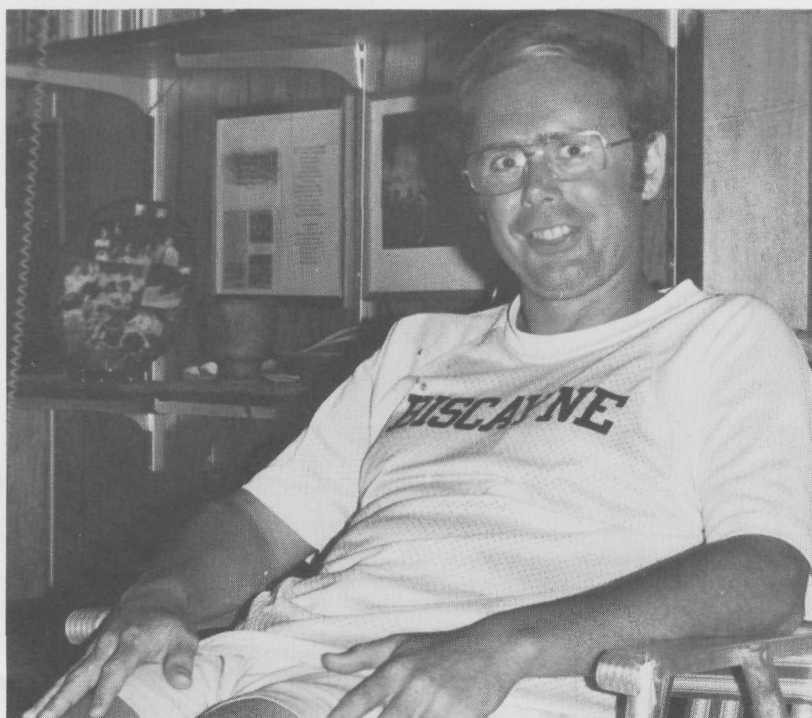


Those of us who have this man as a teacher know him as Fr. Martin. Those of us lucky enough to have him as a friend refer to him as "C. B." (Crazy Bob).

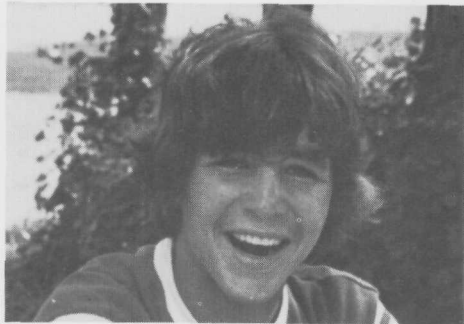
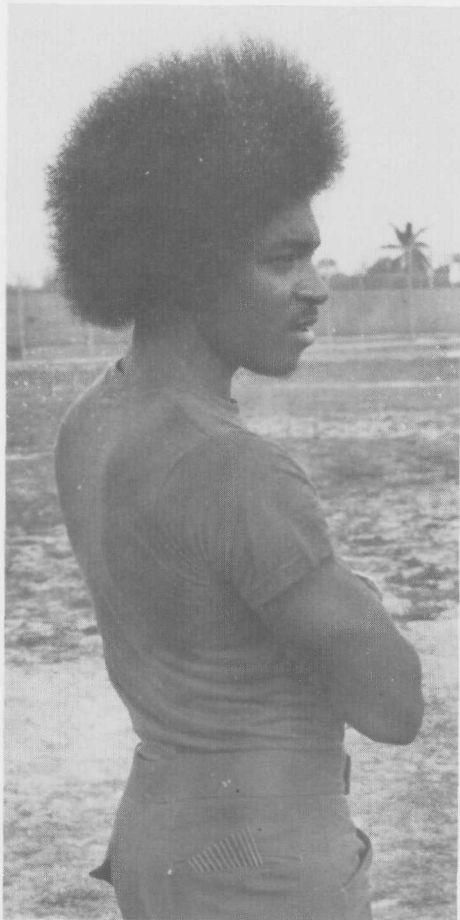
