Circle K is always encouraging students, both residents and commuters, to become members of our family, CIRCLE K INTERNATIONAL.

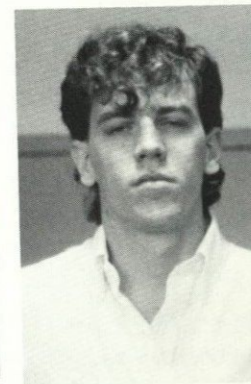
